CHES is an initiative to move select Air Force Information Technology (IT) services, including e-mail, collaboration services, and personal data storage to a private, commercial Cloud.

CHES is the first stage in moving toward the larger EITaaS (Enterprise IT as-a-Service) vision covering a much broader scope of IT services. With the successes of commercial e-mail thus far, AFNIC proved that the Air Force can leverage commercial industry to provide select collaborative tools.
